Important information about public notices

Public Notices

Once you have lodged your application with council, you must put a public notice in a registered newspaper that circulates in the locality of the premises which are the subject of the application. The notice must be given in compliance with regulation 37 or 38 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 as if this application for variation were an application for a renewal of a licence.

The first notice must be published within 20 working days of lodging the application with Council.

The second notice must be published in the same newspaper, not less than 5 days not more than 10 days after the first. (i.e. notify one week apart).

The following newspaper falls into this category:

- Kaipara Lifestyler

A full copy of the page(s) in which the newspaper advertisement has been placed, showing the dates the advertisements were placed and the newspaper the notification featured in, must be forwarded to the District Licensing Committee.
