- Notes that the net proceeds from the sale of any of the sections will be entered into the MELA reserve in accordance with the provisions of the 'Mangawai Empowerment Lands Act 1966' (sic); and
- 8 Withdraws from the MELA reserve the net proceeds from any section sale and uses this amount to reduce Council debt related to the Mangawhai Community Wastewater Scheme (MCWWS); and
- 9 Notes that Council has previously resolved to retain the capital value of the MELA reserve at approximately \$4-5 million and notes that the decision to use the net proceeds of any section sale to reduce MCWWS debt will leave the fund at the same level as before these transactions
