2.1 Class 4 Gambling Venues Policy and Totalisator Agency Board (TAB) Venue Policy – Submission Hearings

The Policy Analyst's report 'Class 4 Gambling Venues Policy and Totalisator Agency Board (TAB) Venue Policy – Submission Hearings' dated 15 June 2015 was circulated.

Graeme Ramsey of the Problem Gambling Foundation was invited to speak to his submission.

Discussion Points:

- Noted that 70% of the Problem Gambling Foundation clients are because of pokie machines.
- 2.5% of adults in New Zealand are experiencing harm from gambling.
- It is much more likely in Maori and Pacifica communities.



- Largest losses are in the poorest communities.
- Gambling is associated with domestic violence, crime and neglect.
- Accessibility to pokies is a critical factor.
- Kaipara sits in the lowest third with regard to national losses statistics.
- The Foundation supports the sinking lid approach.
- Noted that the two policies together address the Foundation's concern about TAB venues and pokies.

"The number of gaming machines permitted to operate at the new venue will not exceed the number permitted to be operated at the existing site OR in the case of clubs, where two or more clubs that merge may consolidate the number of gambling machines operated at the merged non-commercial club venue to the lesser of :

- a) 30 gambling machines: or
- b) the sum of the number of gambling machines previously operated by each non-commercial club individually and is contained in Attachment 1 of the above-mentioned Policy Planner's report; and
- 4 Adopts the Totalisator Agency Board (TAB) Venue Policy, as notified for consultation, and as contained in Attachment 2 of the above-mentioned Policy Planner's report.
