Sport New Zealand Rural Travel Funding 2018/19 Round Two: Summary of Applications

Meeting: Funding Committee (Rural Travel Fund)

Date of meeting: 08 May 2019

Purpose/Ngā whāinga

To provide the Rural Travel Funding Committee the relevant information to award grants to community individuals and/or groups.

Executive summary/Whakarāpopototanga

The Rural Travel Fund scheme is a partnership between Sport New Zealand and KiwiSport, to assist the development of junior sport in rural communities by providing a travel subsidy. The Kaipara District Council currently distributes this through two funding rounds in March and August.

The balance available for the Committee to distribute in the second round for 2018/19 is \$12,736.68. This is made up of a grant of \$10,000.00 received in February 2019 and \$2,736.68 of previously unallocated funds.

Eleven applications totalling \$22,991.58 have been received and ten applications meet the criteria for funding. A portion of the Mangawhai Beach School application is not eligible as the event has already taken place.

The Sport Northland grant can only be carried over to the Summer round for reallocation, and while Sport New Zealand allows for funds from their grant to be carried over, they would raise questions if the amount carried over is significant.
