Independent Investigators play a crucial role in assessing complaints against elected members, ensuring that the principles of fairness, transparency, and accountability are upheld throughout the complaints process. The appointment of Investigators is a vital aspect of maintaining public trust and confidence in Council's governance.

We are seeking Independent Investigators who demonstrate the following key criteria:

- Range of Expertise and Experience: Applicants should possess a broad range of expertise and experience, ideally within the field of local government or related sectors.
- Neutrality and Objectivity: Investigators must maintain neutrality and objectivity throughout all
 proceedings, earning the confidence of both parties involved in the allegations and the wider public.
- Legal and Procedural Knowledge: Understanding of the legal framework and procedural requirements related to local government and council operations, including the ability to understand the specific Code of Conduct adopted by Council.
- Ethical Judgement: Upholding high ethical standards and demonstrating fairness and impartiality in investigations is paramount.
- **Conflict Resolution:** Strong skills in conflict resolution and mediation are essential for facilitating constructive discussions and resolving disputes effectively.
- **Cultural Competence:** Cultural sensitivity, awareness, and knowledge of Tikanga Māori are important for ensuring a respectful and culturally informed approach to investigations.
- **Assessment and Investigative Skills:** Applicants should possess the capability to conduct thorough and impartial investigations, employing effective fact-finding and evidence-gathering techniques.

We encourage eligible individuals or firms meeting the specified criteria to submit their Expressions of interest by Wednesday, 6 March 2024. Following a thorough review process, successful applicants will be appointed to the Council's List of Independent Investigators, available to be called upon in the event of an alleged breach of the code.
